14 and being active DBG gang members.

8 Report No. 09000856.)

17 158. **ANTHONY "ANT" DURANT:** Based on my professional training and experience as a
18 police officer investigating DBG/Towerside criminal street gangs and a review of police reports,
19 sheriff's records, photographs, and other documents, it is my opinion that Mr. Durant("Durant") is an
20 active member of Defendant DBG.

- I personally know Anthony Durant, whose moniker is "Ant."
 - Durant does not report to live in the Proposed Safety Zone.

23 **EVIDENCE OF GANG ACTIVITY – CRIMINAL CONDUCT**

- On November 13, 2008 at 9:32 p.m., SFPD officers detained Durant. (Police Incident Report No. 081217379.) According to the report, Durant was observed with three other known DBG members and associates including Joseph "Stub/z" Smith and Alsedee "Jizz Mac" Green, exit a vehicle in a parking lot across from 1765 Sunnydale Avenue, within

1 the Sunnydale Housing Development. Officers observed that Durant and another
2 member concealed their hands beneath their sweatshirts, a common method of concealing
3 weapons. As SFPD officers approached, all four ran. Durant ran southbound across
4 Sunnydale Avenue and was apprehended by SFPD officers. A subsequent search at
5 Ingleside Station showed Durant in possession of a black ski mask, a pair of batting
6 gloves, and a black knit cap.

- 7 • On November 21, 2008 at 3:27 p.m., SFPD officers responded to the corner of Sunnydale
8 Avenue and Hahn Street, within the Proposed Safety Zone, after being flagged down by
9 an unidentified complainant who expressed fear that something was going to happen.
10 (See Police Report No. 081247097.) According to the report Durant was seen near 1500
11 Sunnydale Avenue with known DBG members and associates including Joseph "Stub/z"
12 Smith, Alsedee "Jizz Mac" Green, Sean "Dough" Beard, and Jason "Jumbo" Jones.
13 Although SFPD received a calls of possible shots fired, no weapons were recovered.
- 14 • On February 11, 2009, Durant was convicted of First Degree Burglary, Conspiracy, and
15 Second Degree Robbery resulting from an April 23, 2008 Daly City arrest.
- 16 • On November 26, 2009, at approximately 2:18 a.m., Durant and other known DBG
17 members and associates including Sean "Dough" Beard were arrested for robbery and
18 conspiracy, near the Proposed Safety Zone. (Police Incident Report No. 091214490.)
19 According to the report, Beard and other known DBG members and associates were
20 driving in a vehicle, when they accosted the victim as he was walking to his sister's
21 house. Beard removed a black semi automatic handgun from the trunk of the vehicle and
22 handed it to Durant. Durant pointed the handgun at the victim and robbed him. The
23 victim jumped Durant, grabbed the gun, and tried to wrestle it from Durant, yelling "You
24 trying to kill me. I'm not gonna let go of this gun." Beard in turn started assaulting the
25 victim with kicks and punches to his body and head. A third person exited the vehicle
26 and joined the assault on the victim, until the victim's sister came out and yelled for them
27 to stop. Beard and the third assailant drove off, and Durant ran after the car. The victim,
28

1 who had succeeded in recovering the weapon, fired several shots in the air. While
2 investigating this incident, SFPD officers recovered a single spent casing and a single live
3 round of .45 auto in front of 271 B Raymond Avenue, four spent casings in front of 269-
4 271 Raymond Avenue, and a single live round in front of 274 Raymond Avenue. SFPD
5 officers also located bullet holes in two vehicles in the area. Witnesses identified both
6 Durant and Beard.

- 7 • On February 19, 2010 at 5:43 a.m., SFPD officers conducted a traffic stop in the area of
8 31 Blythdale Avenue. (Police Report No. 100170012.) According to the report, as SFPD
9 officers approached the stopped vehicle, one passenger exited the front passenger side
10 and fled westbound into the Sunnydale Housing Development. Durant, identified by
11 SFPD officers as the driver, opened the driver's door and began to flee, dropping a small
12 black object shaped like a gun onto the ground. SFPD officers watched Durant pick up
13 the gun, and run southeast towards Sunrise Avenue, evading capture.

- During a May 7, 2009 San Francisco Sheriff's Department classification and interview, Glass admitted membership in DBG.
- Glass reports to reside within the Proposed Safety Zone, in DBG turf.

1 police officers behind the buildings or "cuts" along Hahn Street. Witnesses saw Smith
2 throw an object onto the roof near 226 Hahn Street. Police officers also discovered bullet
3 holes, spent rounds and bullet fragments in and around the building located at 1429
4 Sunnydale Avenue. Smith was arrested on charges of attempted homicide and illegal
5 possession of a loaded firearm. Glass was subsequently arrested on May 6, 2009 at 6:00
6 a.m. on charges of assault with a deadly weapon, illegal possession of a loaded firearm,
7 with a gang enhancement. (See Supplemental Police Incident Report No. 090068024.)

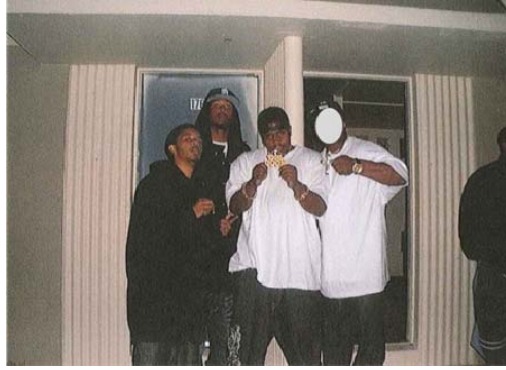

- During a January 1, 2009 date San Francisco Sheriff's Department classification and interview, Green admitted membership in DBG.
- Green does report to live in the Proposed Safety Zone.

17 officers with his hands inside his shorts, a gesture SFPD officers believed was consistent
18 with Green concealing a firearm. Green proceeded to sit on the trunk of a parked car,
19 concealing his hands and said to the SFPD officers: "Yeah, I was talking to you! You
20 heard me! You know what happened in Oakland! You scared! You should be!" SFPD
21 officers believed that Green was referring to the recent murder of four police officers in
22 Oakland. Green was subsequently arrested for criminal threats and obstructing a police
23 officer's duties.
- 24 • On April 19, 2009, at 2:29 pm, members of DBG and TOWERSIDE congregated at
25 Blythdale Avenue and Hahn Street. Green, along with ten other DBG members and
26 associates including Raymond "Boo Gotti" Rodgers and Aliton "Tiggz" Woodson were
27 present. Ten TOWERSIDE gang members and associates were present, including

1 Howard "Howie T" Dixon, Vincent "VC" Floyd, Marcus "Young Monz" Gaines, Ceabe
2 "CB" Justin, and Diondre "D-Nice" Young. Green asked SFPD officers if they would
3 just let the two groups fight. Members from both groups taunted one another yelling,
4 throwing hands in the air, and challenging and taunting one another.

- 5 • On January 1, 2010, at 3:58 am, SFPD officers responded to a report of shots fired in the
6 area of Sunnydale Avenue and Santos Street. (Police Incident Report No. 100000992.)
7 According to the report, while SFPD officers were en route to respond to the shots fired,

9 Persia Street. Known DBG members Tantrell "Trail Mix: Crawford and George "G-

11 loaded black, semi-automatic handgun under the front passenger seat, where Crawford
12 had been previously sitting. Washington, Crawford, and Green were arrested on weapons
13 and gang charges.

161. **FLOYD "FREAK" JACKSON:** Based on my professional training and experience as a police officer investigating DBG/Towerside criminal street gangs and a review of police reports, sheriff's records, photographs, and other documents, it is my opinion that Floyd Jackson ("Jackson") is an active member of Defendant DBG gang.

- I personally know Jackson, whose moniker is "Freak."
- During an August 8, 2008 San Francisco Sheriff's Department classification and interview, Jackson admitted membership in DBG.
- Jackson does report to live in the Proposed Safety Zone.

EVIDENCE OF GANG ACTIVITY – CRIMINAL CONDUCT

- On February 14, 2007, at 1:37 pm, SFPD officers responded to a call of gunshots reportedly fired by passengers riding in a silver-colored vehicle. That incident occurred at Persia Avenue and Mission Street. (Police Incident Report No. 070163876.)
According to the reports, the vehicle was subsequently seen in a parking lot at the Sunnydale Housing Development. As SFPD officers approached the vehicle, Jackson and known DBG member Deshawn "Posso" Byes, exited the vehicle and soon started running from SFPD officers, crossing through the "cuts" of the housing development. (The cuts are the areas in between the public housing buildings.) Jackson evaded police.
- On February 21, 2007, at 2:05 p.m., police observed Jackson and known DBG member Emon "Flav/e" Brown riding a dirt bike illegally in the Proposed Safety Zone. (Police Report No. 070189361.) According to the report, upon seeing police, Jackson got off the dirt bike and ran into the Sunnydale Housing Development, where he eluded capture. Police caught Brown, conducted a search incident to arrest, and uncovered suspected cocaine base for sale and marijuana. A computer check revealed that the dirt bike was reported stolen.
- On July 9, 2007, at 12:50 p.m. Jackson was shot in the area of Sunnydale Avenue and

1 Hahn Street. (Police Incident Report #070689208) According to the report, Jackson
2 reported walking towards the Little Village Market at Sunnydale and Hahn. Jackson
3 reported hearing a vehicle speed up behind him and shots fired and then feeling
4 something hit him in the right hand.

- 5 • On August 28, 2007 at 2:05 p.m. Jackson was observed by SFPD officers walking
6 through the area near Santos Street and Sunnydale Avenue. (Police Incident Report No.
7 070878780.) According to the report, once Jackson made eye contact with the SFPD
8 officers, he began running holding his waistband as if concealing a handgun. SFPD
9 officers saw Jackson fall, take out a revolver from his waistband and throw it to the
10 ground. SFPD officers recovered a loaded Taurus .357 revolver. Jackson was arrested
11 and subsequently convicted of illegal firearm possession.
- 12 • On November 7, 2007, at 1:39 pm, SFPD officers investigated what appeared to be a
13 burglary in progress. (Police Incident Report No. 071144033). According to the report,
14 SFPD officers saw Jackson hide a chrome gun under a couch cushion at 1540 Sunnydale
15 Avenue. Jackson was with known DBG member Manuel "Fresh" Rose. Both Rose and
16 Jackson resisted arrest, and Jackson punched an SFPD officer in the face. SFPD officers
17 recovered two guns from the couch and individually wrapped baggies of suspected
18 marijuana safety clipped inside Rose's jeans near the upper inner thigh area. At the time
19 of this arrest, Jackson was on felony probation until October 3, 2010, and had a stay away
20 order from the Sunnydale Housing Development until September 13, 2010. Rose was
21 also a convicted felon and was on two active grants of probation. In early 2010, Jackson
22 was convicted of illegal firearm possession and was found to be a gang member.
23 Jackson's sentence on these charges included a stay away from the Sunnydale Housing
24 Development and from any known DBG member.
- 25 • On April 20, 2010, at 3:34 p.m., Jackson was observed loitering in the Proposed Safety
26 Zone at 52 Brookdale Avenue in violation of a condition of his parole. Jackson fled
27 when officers approached. (Field Interview Report No. 10001105.)
