

1 173. **JOSEPH "STUB/Z" SMITH:** Based on my professional training and experience as a
2 police officer investigating DBG/Towerside criminal street gangs and a review of police reports,
3 sheriff's records, photographs, and other documents, it is my opinion that Joseph Smith ("Smith") is an
4 active member of Defendant DBG gang.

- 5 • I personally know Smith, whose moniker is "Stub/z."
- 6 • Smith does not report to live in the Proposed Safety Zone.
- 7 • Smith has several tattoos, including on his right forearm: a jester with the word "LOW" at
8 the top, and the numbers "324" worked into the tattoo. Smith also has a tattoo on the
9 back of his right hand, "RIP," and on the back of his left hand, "Tro." "RIP Tro" refers to
10 murdered DBG member Dante Rollins.

2 **EVIDENCE OF GANG ACTIVITY – CRIMINAL CONDUCT**

- 3
- 4 • On January 29, 2008 at 6:38 p.m., Smith was stopped by police for driving recklessly
5 within the Proposed Safety Zone, on DBG turf. (Police Incident Report No. 080102466.)
6 According to the report, a search of Smith's vehicle revealed a loaded, concealed firearm,
7 over \$700 in cash, and nineteen rocks of suspected base cocaine, packaged for sale.
8 Smith was arrested.
 - 9 • On October 6, 2008 at 2:12 p.m., SFPD officers attempted to detain Smith and a juvenile
10 companion for questioning regarding an armed robbery. Smith took off running through
11 the neighborhood and ran into an open doorway at 62 Blythdale Avenue, a private
12 residence within the Proposed Safety Zone. Officers apprehended Smith inside the
13 residence and arrested him for trespassing. The 51 year-old female victim stated that she
14 did not know Smith. Smith stated to police that he "saw the open door and went in."
15 (Police Report No. 081065758.)
 - 16 • On October 25, 2008 at 15:20, Smith was cited for trespassing within the Proposed Safety
17 Zone. (Police Report No. 081143398.) According to the report, an officer observed
18 Smith sitting with companions outside 1763 Sunnydale amidst numerous items of trash
19 (papers and bottles). Smith refused to comply with the officer's questions and was
20 arrested.
 - 21 • On January 19, 2009 at 2:45 p.m., SFPD officers observed Smith, at the intersection
22 Sunnydale Avenue and Hahn Street, within the Proposed Safety Zone, disembark from
23 known DBG member Stephen "Stevie Mac" Glass's vehicle and fire shots at a suspected
24 rival gang member on Sunnydale Avenue. (Police Report No. 090068024.) According to
25 the report, while attempting to evade police, Smith ran into the areas in between the
26 residences located on Hahn Street. SFPD officers pursued Smith through the
27 neighborhood, and eventually arrested him. After the incident, SFPD officers discovered
28 multiple bullet holes on the side of a private residence, two of which were in a second

1 story window. Police also observed numerous bullet holes in the sheet rock wall of the
2 residence's front room. Smith and Glass are currently awaiting trial on these charges.

3 **EVIDENCE OF GANG ACTIVITY – ASSOCIATION**

- 4 • On September 5, 2007 at 4:30 p.m., Smith was detained on the 1800 block of Sunnydale
5 Avenue on DBG turf and within the Proposed Safety Zone, with known DBG member
6 Wallace "Gater/Swally" Pellette who was arrested for driving without a license. (Police
7 Report No. 070909090.)
- 8 • On October 17, 2007 at 4:50 p.m., SFPD officers observed Smith and several known
9 DBG members and associates including Stephen "Stevie Mac" Glass and Alex "Pee
10 Wee" Price, loitering in front of 1822 Sunnydale Avenue on DBG turf and within the
11 Proposed Safety Zone. (Field Interview Report No. 08000185).
- 12 • On January 1, 2008 at 4:10 p.m. Smith was observed with known DBG member Alex
13 "Pee Wee" Price at 1822 Sunnydale Avenue within the Proposed Safety Zone. (Field
14 Interview Report No. 08000462.)
- 15 • On January 10, 2008 at 4:45 p.m. Smith was seen loitering in the area of 1765 Sunnydale
16 Avenue, within the Proposed Safety Zone, with known DBG member Alsedee "Jizz Mac"
17 Green. (Field Interview Report No. 08000060.)
- 18 • On January 15, 2008, at 1:04 p.m., SFPD officers saw Emon "Flav/e" Brown in the
19 Proposed Safety Zone riding in the front passenger seat of a vehicle in the company of
20 Smith. (Police Report No. 080051415.) When the vehicle came to a stop, Brown fled
21 from police, holding his right hand suspiciously on his waistband as if holding a firearm.
- 22 • On January 22, 2008 at 5:18 p.m. Smith was seen loitering in the area of 1820 Sunnydale
23 Avenue , within the Proposed Safety Zone, with known DBG members including Alsedee
24 "Jizz Mac" Green, Stephen "Steve Mac" Glass, and Wallace "Gater/Swally" Pellette.
25 (Field Interview Report No. 08000114.)
- 26 • On March 6, 2008 12:58 p.m. SFPD officers were patrolling the area of the Sunnydale
27 Housing Development when they saw several DBG members and associates loitering in

1 the parking lot near 1820 Sunnydale Avenue, within the Proposed Safety Zone. (Police
2 Incident Report No. 080240527) According to the report, there were seven known DBG
3 members and associates loitering in the parking lot including Smith, Wallace
4 "Gater/Swally" Pellette, Deantray "Tray" Reed, and Aliton "Tiggz" Woodson. Pellette
5 attempted to hide something in a nearby car but was unsuccessful. SFPD officers found a
6 loaded semiautomatic handgun with an obliterated serial number in a car that appeared to
7 belong to Pellette. Pellette was subsequently convicted of carrying a concealed weapon.

- 8 • On March 7, 2008 at 3:00 p.m. Smith was seen loitering with known DBG members and
9 associates, including Alsedee "Jizz Mac" Green and Kim "K.I." Mitchell, Jr., in the area
10 of 1765 Sunnydale Avenue, in the Proposed Safety Zone. (Field Interview Report No.
11 08000239.)
- 12 • On March 8, 2008 at 10:00 p.m. Smith was seen in the company of known DBG
13 members including Alsedee "Jizz Mac" Green driving in the area of 1536 Geneva
14 Avenue, just outside of the Proposed Safety Zone. (Field Interview Report No.
15 08000262.)
- 16 • On March 9, 2008 at 6:30 p.m. Smith was observed with known DBG members Alsedee
17 "Jizz Mac" Green, Stephen "Steve Mac" Glass and Deshawn "Posso" Byes, and an
18 Oakdale Mob gang member, at 1822 Sunnydale Avenue, in the Proposed Safety Zone.
19 (Field Interview Report No. 08000328.)
- 20 • On March 13, 2008 at 4:00 p.m. Smith was observed with known DBG members and
21 associates, including Alsedee "Jizz Mac" Green, Deantray "Tray" Reed, and Stephen
22 "Steve Mac" Glass, at 1765 Sunnydale Avenue, in the Proposed Safety Zone. (Field
23 Interview Report No. 08000296.)
- 24 • On April 23, 2008 at 1:15p.m. Smith was observed with known DBG members and
25 associates, including Alsedee "Jizz Mac" Green and Stephen "Stevie Mac" Glass, at 124
26 Blythdale Avenue, in the Proposed Safety Zone. In addition to DBG members, there
27

1 were also associates of the Up the Hill gang loitering with these DBG members. (Field
2 Interview Report No. 08000417.)

- 3 • On April 23, 2008 at 7:00 p.m. Smith was observed with known DBG members and
4 associates, including Samoa "Kilo" Lefiti and Alsedee "Jizz Mac" Green, loitering in
5 front of 1818 Sunnydale Avenue, in the Proposed Safety Zone. (Field Interview Report
6 No. 08000416.)
- 7 • On April 29, 2008 at 3:08 p.m., Smith was detained at 1538 Sunnydale Avenue on DBG
8 turf, and in the Proposed Safety Zone, with several known DBG members and associates
9 including Wallace "Gater/Swally" Pellete, Alsedee "Jizz Mac" Green, Kim "K.I."
10 Mitchell, and Aliton "Tiggz" Woodson. DBG member Pellete was arrested for
11 possession of marijuana for sale. (Police Report No. 080448862.)
- 12 • On May 9, 2008, at 9:00 a.m. Smith was observed with known DBG member Stephen
13 "Stevie Mac" Glass at 1820 Sunnydale Avenue, in the Proposed Safety Zone. (Field
14 Interview Report No. 08000473.)
- 15 • On May 17, 2008, at 10:12 p.m., Smith was seen loitering with known DBG members
16 and associates, including Stephen "Stevie Mac" Glass, Alsedee "Jizz Mac" Green, Kim
17 "K.I." Mitchell, Jr., Deshawn "Posso" Byes, as well as an Oakdale Mob gang member, in
18 a parking lot at 1820 Sunnydale (also known as "Stevie's Lot"), in the Proposed Safety
19 Zone. (Field Interview Report No. 08000532.)
- 20 • On May 27, 2008, at 2:45 p.m., Smith was seen loitering with known DBG members and
21 associates, including Samoa "Kilo" Lefiti and Alsedee "Jizz Mac" Green, at 60 Brookdale
22 Avenue in the Proposed Safety Zone. (Field Interview Report No. 08000590.)
- 23 • On June 2, 2008, at 2:20 p.m., Smith was seen loitering with known DBG members and
24 associates, including Stephen "Stevie Mac" Glass, Samoa "Kilo" Lefiti, and Alsedee "Jizz
25 Mac" Green, at 1820 Sunnydale Avenue in the Proposed Safety Zone. (Field Interview
26 Report No. 08000616.)

- On June 14, 2008 at 5:21 p.m., Smith was observed with known DBG member Samoa "Kilo" Lefiti and a juvenile associate, at 1500 Sunnydale Avenue, in the Proposed Safety Zone, after shots were fired. As officers approached, the juvenile took off running into the neighborhood while holding a firearm. The juvenile threw the gun in the direction of 1505 Sunnydale, and was later apprehended. (Police Report No. 080623597.)
 - On July 10, 2008 at 3:00 p.m., Smith was observed in a green Lexus with known DBG member Jason "Jumbo" Jones at the intersection of Hahn Street and Visitacion Avenue, in the Proposed Safety Zone. (Field Interview Report No. 08000928.)
 - On July 31, 2008 at 2:20 p.m., Smith was observed loitering with known DBG members including Jason "Jumbo" Jones and Aliton "Tiggz" Woodson at 1765 Sunnydale Avenue, in the Proposed Safety Zone. (Field Interview Report No. 08001005.)
 - On August 7, 2008, at 1:48 p.m., Smith was seen loitering with known DBG members and associates, including Wallace "Gater/Swally" Pellette, Samoa "Kilo" Lefiti, Aliton "Tiggz" Woodson, Kim "K.I." Mitchell, Jr., Alsedee "Jizz Mac" Green, and an Oakdale Mob gang member, at 1751 Sunnydale Avenue in the Proposed Safety Zone. (Field Interview Report No. 08001016.)
 - On August 30, 2008 at 4:30 p.m., SFPD officers observed 14 known DBG gang members and associates together at a Kezar Pavilion youth football gang, including the following Wallace "Gater" Pellette, Jason "Jumbo" Jones, Joseph "Stub/z" Smith, Deantray "Tray" Reed, Kim "KI" Mitchell, Kevin "Duke" Mitchell, Aliton "Tiggz" Woodson, and an Oakdale Mob gang member.
 - On September 19, 2008, at 10:14 p.m., Smith was seen loitering with known DBG members and associates, including Wallace "Gater" Pellette, Alsedee "Jizz Mac" Green, and Sean "Dough" Beard, at 1765 Sunnydale Avenue, in the Proposed Safety Zone. (Field Interview Report No. 08001234.)
 - On November 5, 2008 at 12:00, officers observed Smith with known DBG members Jason "Jumbo" Jones, Samoa "Kilo" Lefiti, and Alsedee Green, within the Proposed

1 Safety Zone. All individuals were detained for questioning regarding an incident in the
2 Southern Police District where an individual was threatened with a gun. (Police Report
3 No. 081184217.)

- 4 • On November 10, 2008, at 1:40 p.m., Smith was seen loitering with known DBG
5 members and associates, including Sean "Dough" Beard, Jason "Jumbo" Jones, and
6 Alsedee "Jizz Mac" Green, at 11 Brookdale Avenue, in the Proposed Safety Zone. (Field
7 Interview Report No. 09000357.)
- 8 • On November 13, 2008 at 9:32 p.m. SFPD observed Smith with three other known DBG
9 members and associates, including Alsedee "Jizz Mac" Green and Anthony "Ant" Durant,
10 exit a vehicle in a parking lot across from 1765 Sunnydale Avenue, within the Proposed
11 Safety Zone. (Police Incident Report No. 081217379.) According to the report, Officers
12 observed that Durant and another member concealed their hands beneath their
13 sweatshirts, a common method of concealing weapons. As SFPD officers approached, all
14 four ran. Durant ran southbound across Sunnydale Avenue and was apprehended by
15 SFPD officers. A subsequent search at Ingleside Station showed Durant in possession of
16 a black ski mask, a pair of batting gloves, and a black knit cap.
- 17 • On November 21, 2008 at 3:27 p.m. SFPD officers responded to the corner of Sunnydale
18 Avenue and Hahn Street, within the Proposed Safety Zone, after being flagged down by
19 an unidentified complainant who expressed fear that something was going to happen.
20 (See Police Report No. 081247097.) According to the report Alsedee "Jizz Mac" Green
21 was seen near 1500 Sunnydale Avenue with known DBG members and associates
22 including Smith, Sean "Dough" Beard, Anthony "Ant" Durant, and Jason "Jumbo" Jones.
- 23 • On November 26, 2008, at 3:40 p.m., Smith was seen loitering with known DBG
24 members and associates, including Raymond "Boo Gotti" Rodgers, Jason "Jumbo" Jones,
25 Aliton "Tiggz" Woodson, and Alsedee "Jizz Mac" Green, at 60 Brookdale Avenue, in the
26 Proposed Safety Zone. (Field Interview Report No. 08001667.)

- On January 5, 2009 at 14:30, officers observed Smith with known DBG members and associates Jason "Jumbo" Jones, Aliton "Tiggz" Woodson, Alsedee "Jizz Mac" Green, and Stephen "Stevie Mac" Glass, on DBG turf and within the Proposed Safety Zone. Police were unsuccessful in obtaining a statement from Jones about the shooting of a DBG associate a few days prior. (Police Report No. 090015263.)

 - Washington does not report to live in the Proposed Safety Zone.

- On August 8, 2009 at 12:44 p.m. SFPD officers were patrolling the area of the Sunnydale Housing Development. (Police Incident Report No. 090806501.) According to the report, SFPD officers observed known DBG member Tantrell "Trail Mix" Crawford and two juvenile DBG members, standing on the east side of Santos Street at Brookdale Avenue. One DBG juvenile was held both of his hands out simulating that he was firing two handguns and "aiming" at the northwest corner of Brookdale Avenue and Santos Street. SFPD officers observed another group of known DBG gang members including Washington standing near the northwest corner of Brookdale Avenue and Santos Street, one of the DBG members using a silver cell phone to simulate firing a gun. Yet another juvenile DBG member simulated firing his "guns" on a marked police vehicle.
 - On August 16, 2009, at 2:07 p.m. SFPD officers observed a group of people in front of 21 Santos Street. (Police Incident Report No. 090836699) According to the report, Washington looked at SFPD officers and ran. Police apprehended Washington hiding against the doorway to 1581 Sunnydale Avenue.
 - On December 28, 2009 at 9:30 a.m. Daly City police officers responded to the area around 615 Schwerin in response to a shooting of two TOWERSIDE gang members. (Police Incident Report No. DCPD09-011126.) According to the report, known TOWERSIDE members Edgar "Arrow" Floyd and Vincent " VC" Floyd were shot at by unknown suspects. Other known TOWERSIDE members Orlando "Anthony" Ware and Marcus "Young Monz" Gaines were in the vicinity when the shooting occurred. Daly City police officers identified Washington's cars as being driven in the area of the shooting.
 - On January 1, 2010, at 3:58 am, SFPD officers responded to a report of shots fired in the area of Sunnydale Avenue and Santos Street. (Police Incident Report No. 100000992.) According to the report, while SFPD officers were en route to respond to the shots fired, officers observed Alsedee "Jizz Mac" Green enter a car parked at the intersection of Sunnydale Avenue and Persia Street. Known DBG members Tantrell "Trail Mix:

1 Crawford and Washington were in the car. SFPD officers conducted a traffic stop and
2 found a loaded black, semi-automatic handgun under the front passenger seat, where
3 Crawford had been previously sitting. Washington, Crawford, and Green were arrested
4 on weapons and gang charges.

- 5 • On February 17, 2010 at 6:58 p.m., Washington was arrested in the Proposed Safety
6 Zone. (Police Report No. 090979095.) According to the report, SFPD officers contacted
7 Washington and known DBG members Christopher "C&H" Byes and Tantrell "Trail
8 Mix" Crawford at 103 Blythdale Avenue. A search of the apartment revealed numerous
9 individually packaged baggies of suspected marijuana, paraphernalia associated with
10 drug sales including a digital scale and numerous small baggies as well as a loaded semi-
11 automatic handgun with the serial number scratched off. Byes, Washington and Crawford
12 were all arrested for conspiracy, marijuana possession for sale, illegal firearm possession,
13 and being active DBG gang members.
- 14 • On April 26, 2010, at 1450 Sunnydale Avenue at 2:10 p.m. SFPD officers observed
15 Washington and known DBG member Jordan "J.O." Jordan walking in between the
16 building lines near 15 Brookdale Avenue. (Police Incident Report No. 100038558)
17 According to the report, Jordan and Washington saw police and tried to evade contact.
18 Jordan reached into the front of his waistband and started running away from officers,
19 running through the basketball courts at the Sunnydale Housing Development and ending
20 at the Little Village Market at the intersection of Sunnydale Avenue and Hahn Street.
21 After apprehending Jordan, SFPD officers searched his person and found marijuana
22 packaged for sale. Jordan was arrested. Washington evaded capture.

- 25 • On August 27, 2009, at 7:47 p.m., Washington was seen loitering with known DBG
26 members and associates, including Alsedee "Jizz Mac" Green, at 17 Blythdale Avenue, in
27 the Proposed Safety Zone. (Field Interview Report No. 09000859.)

- During a July 2, 2009 San Francisco Sheriff's Department classification and interview, Wilson admitted membership in DBG.
- Wilson does not report to live in the Proposed Safety Zone.

- On August 22, 2006 at 5:45 p.m., Wilson was seen loitering at 1652 Sunnydale Avenue in the company of known DBG members and associates. (Field Interview Report No. 07000220 and Police Incident Report No. 060893663.) SFPD officers recovered a replica firearm/air gun and twenty bags of suspected marijuana were found in the bushes nearby.
 - On April 10, 2007, at 10:36 pm, SFPD officers responded to Santos Street and Blythdale Avenue regarding a report of person with a gun. (Police Incident Report No. 070368797.) According to the report, Wilson matched dispatch's description of the suspect. When SFPD officers made contact with Wilson, Wilson held in his hand an empty shell casing and a live round wrapped inside of a tissue.
 - On September 6, 2007, witnesses heard multiple shots fired and observed known DBG members Emon "Flav/e" Brown and Joc Wilson standing on the 1400 block of Sunnydale. (Police Incident Report No. 070911120.) According to the report, witnesses reported that one of the two fired a semi-automatic pistol. A witness also noted that there was an exchange of gunfire between rival DBG and TOWERSIDE gang members. Police recovered two spent bullet casings and a bullet projectile stuck in iron security bars covering a window in front of 1321 Sunnydale. Police also noted that a nearby vehicle suffered possible bullet ricochet damage to the driver's door. Witnesses identified Brown and Wilson as the shooters.
 - On September 15, 2007 at 6:43 p.m. SFPD officers saw Wilson near the intersection of Sunnydale Avenue and Santos Street. (Police Incident Report No. 070947959) Just two days previously, Wilson was observed standing in front of 1770 Sunnydale with both of his hands tucked under his waistband. As officers approached, Wilson fled and SFPD officers subsequently recovered a 9mm firearm with an extended magazine from Wilson's flight path. Wilson eluded capture on that day. (See Police Incident Report No. 070938889.) On September 15, 2007, as officers approached Wilson to arrest him for the September 13, 2007 incident, Wilson began running, keeping his hands underneath his

1 body, and near his waistband area. Wilson was subsequently apprehended by SFPD. As
2 SFPD officers escorted Wilson to the police vehicle, a 9mm handgun fell from Wilson's
3 right pant leg and onto the ground. SFPD officers also seized a black mask and a black
4 bandana from Wilson. Wilson was convicted of illegal firearm possession and subjected
5 gang probation conditions.

- 6 • In early 2010, Wilson resolved both of the September 2007 weapons arrests and was
7 convicted of illegal firearms possession and was subject to gang conditions as part of
8 probation.
- 9 • On April 20, 2010, at 4:47 p.m., Wilson was seen in the company of Emon "Flav/e"
10 Brown in Oakdale Mob gang turf within the Bayview Police District. (Police Incident
11 Report No. 100366073.) Both Wilson and Emon "Flav/e" Brown were in violation of
12 conditions of their respective gang probation restricting them from associating with one
13 another for being fellow DBG members.

14 **EVIDENCE OF GANG ACTIVITY – ASSOCIATION**

- 15 • On July 22, 2007, at 5:55 p.m., Wilson was observed loitering at 1846 Sunnydale
16 Avenue, in the Proposed Safety Zone, with known DBG members and associates,
17 including Floyd "Freak" Jackson, Emon "Flav/e" Brown, Kim "K.I." Mitchell, and
18 Tantrell "Trail Mix" Crawford. (Police Report No. 070740690.)
- 19 • On August 30, 2007, at 2:49 p.m., Emon "Flav/e" Brown was arrested for trespassing on
20 the 1500 Block of Sunnydale, while in the company of known DBG gang member, Joc
21 Wilson. (Police Report No. 070887509.) Wilson was detained by SFPD.

22 **EVIDENCE OF GANG ACTIVITY – INDICIA**

- 23 • Police have discovered the following photographs depicting Wilson associating with
24 known DBG members.

- On June 5, 2007, Wilson put \$100 dollars on Edgar Diaz's books during a visit at the Alameda County Jail. On September 14, 2007, Wilson put \$50 dollars on Edgar Diaz's books during a visit at the Alameda County Jail.

176. **ALITON "TIGGZ" WOODSON:** Based on my professional training and experience as a police officer investigating DBG/Towerside criminal street gangs and a review of police reports, sheriff's records, photographs, and other documents, it is my opinion that Aliton Woodson ("Woodson") is an active member of Defendant DBG gang.

- I personally know Woodson, whose moniker is "Tiggz."
- Woodson does not report to live in the Proposed Safety Zone.

EVIDENCE OF GANG ACTIVITY – CRIMINAL CONDUCT

- On March 16, 2008, at 10:24 p.m., SFPD officers conducted a traffic stop near the 1900 block of Sunnydale Avenue. (Police Incident Report No. 080286333) According to the report, Kim Mitchell was driving the car and known DBG member Aliton "Tiggz" Woodson was the passenger. SFPD officers searched Kim Mitchell, who was on probation and had a warrantless search condition. SFPD officers discovered a stolen

1 loaded firearm tucked into Woodson's waistband. In response, Woodson stated, "Shit,
2 fuck you asshole bitches." Woodson was arrested on weapons charges.

- 3 • On April 1, 2008, Woodson was convicted in San Mateo County of possession of
4 marijuana.
- 5 • On May 28, 2008 at 6:48 p.m. SFPD officers investigated a gathering of a group of 8 to
6 10 black males including Woodson, walking towards the police substation on Sunnydale
7 Avenue. (Police Incident Report No. 080560961) According to the report, SFPD
8 officers watched the group board a MUNI 9 San Bruno bus and stand inside the bus just
9 in front of the rear doors. SFPD officers reported seeing an Asian male, sitting down and
10 being attacked by the group. Officers ran to intervene, yet they only apprehended only
11 four of the group, while the others, including Woodson, fled. One of the gang members
12 in the group was wearing pants with "DBG" written on them.
- 13 • On October 16, 2008, Woodson was served with a Summons and Complaint for
14 Injunctive Relief by the San Francisco Housing Authority. (Police Incident Report No.
15 080286333.) On April 3, 2009, a judgment was entered against Woodson imposing a
16 civil stay away order from all San Francisco Housing Authority property.
- 17 • On November 1, 2009, at 5:55 p.m., SFPD responded to a MUNI robbery at Visitacion
18 Avenue and Sawyer Street. (Police Incident Report No. 091128073) According to the
19 report, SFPD officers spoke to the robbery victim, who was suffering from a laceration to
20 the right side of her head. The victim explained that five black males on the bus were
21 throwing around a flashlight. When the victim attempted to exit the bus at Visitacion
22 Avenue and Sawyer Street, two of the black males blocked the door and the other three
23 approached her from behind and began to violently tug on her purse. The victim tried to
24 hold onto her purse and exit the bus, but they would not let her leave. The victim was
25 suddenly pushed off of the bus, and fell head first on the pavement. One of the suspects
26 then took her purse off of her shoulder, and they all fled. Subsequent review of the
27 onboard MUNI camera would reveal that Woodson entered and left the bus. Woodson

1 and another known DBG member would be identified on the video as taking part in the
2 assault.

- 3 • On November 24, 2009 at 3:54 p.m. SFPD officers saw Woodson in the Sunnydale
4 Housing Development in violation of his civil stay away order. (Police Incident Report
5 No. 091209758.) According to the report, SFPD officers made contact with Woodson
6 and chased him within the Sunnydale Housing Development. When Woodson was
7 apprehended and informed that he had a civil stay away order, Woodson responded, "I
8 don't give a fuck!...I'll be out and back tomorrow." Woodson's mother echoed her son's
9 comments, saying to SFPD officers, "[e]very mother fucker out here has a stay away
10 order. You mother fuckers see him out here everyday and now you want to arrest him."
11 As SFPD officers were booking Woodson at Ingleside Police Station, Woodson taunted
12 the officers saying to one, "You better watch out. I'm gonna fuck your wife. I'm gonna
13 fuck your daughter. Let catch you without your badge and gun." During this arrest,
14 Woodson also called SFPD officers, a "bunch of faggots...You're a bunch of pussies. You
15 can't even walk through the Sunnydale, you are faggots. You think your the shit with
16 your badge and gun." Woodson was booked for threats, resisting, and violation of his
17 stay away order.

- 18 • On March 11, 2010, SFPD officers were parked at Leland and Sawyer when they heard
19 four to six gunshots coming from the area of the Sunnydale Housing Development.
20 (Police Incident Report No. 100234715.) According to the report, SFPD officers arrived
21 at the intersection of Sunnydale and Santos, and saw Woodson and another individual
22 walking eastbound from a playground located at Brookdale and Santos. SFPD officers
23 ordered Woodson and his companion to stop, but they continued to walk away. SFPD
24 officers saw Woodson grab his waistband area with his right hand and run southeast into
25 the basketball courts at the Sunnydale Housing Development. SFPD officers chased
26 Woodson, seeing him crouch behind a white car located at 30 Castillo Street, and then
27 hiding on a staircase leading to 50 Castillo. SFPD officers arrested Woodson, who was

1 in violation of a stay away order, and located a Beretta 9mm handgun with an extended
2 magazine in front of 30 Castillo Street, just under a white car, in front of the rear
3 passenger tire. SFPD officers also found Woodson to be in possession of suspected
4 marijuana, along with \$140 US currency in mixed denominations. Woodson plead guilty
5 to possession of a loaded weapon and being an active gang member and had gang
6 conditions imposed as a condition of probation.

7 8 **EVIDENCE OF GANG ACTIVITY – ASSOCIATION**

- 9
- 10 • On March 6, 2008 12:58 p.m. SFPD officers were patrolling the area of the Sunnydale
11 Housing Development when they saw several DBG members and associates loitering in
12 the parking lot near 1820 Sunnydale Avenue, in the Proposed Safety Zone. (Police
13 Incident Report No. 080240527) According to the report, there were seven known DBG
14 members and associates loitering in the parking lot including Woodson, Wallace
15 "Gater/Swally" Pellette, Deantray "Tray" Reed, and Joseph "Stub/z" Smith. Pellette
16 attempted to hide something in a nearby car but was unsuccessful. SFPD officers found a
17 loaded semiautomatic handgun with an obliterated serial number in a car that appeared to
18 belong to Pellette. Pellette was subsequently convicted of carrying a concealed weapon.
 - 19 • On April 29, 2008, at 3:08 pm, Woodson was observed in 1583 Sunnydale Avenue, in the
20 Proposed Safety Zone, with known DBG members and associates including Wallace
21 "Gater/Swally" Pellette, Joseph "Stub/z" Smith, Alsedee "Jizz Mac" Green, and Kim
22 "K.I." Mitchell. (Police Incident Report No. 080448862.)
 - 23 • On July 31, 2008 at 2:20 p.m., Woodson was observed loitering with known DBG
24 members including Joseph "Stub/z" Smith and Jason "Jumbo" Jones at 1765 Sunnydale
25 Avenue, in the Proposed Safety Zone. (Field Interview Report No. 08001005.)
 - 26 • On August 7, 2008, at 1:48 p.m., Woodson was seen loitering at 1751 Sunnydale Avenue,
27 in the Proposed Safety Zone, with known DBG members and associates, including
28 Samoa "Kilo" Lefiti, Alsedee "Jizz Mac" Green, Wallace "Gater/Swally" Pellette, Kim

1 "K.I." Mitchell, Jr., Joseph "Stub/z" Smith, and an Oakdale Mob gang member. (Field
2 Interview Report No. 08001016.)

- 3 • On August 27, 2008 at 2:20 p.m., Woodson was observed loitering with a known DBG
4 member/associate Jones at 1765 Sunnydale Avenue, in the Proposed Safety Zone. (Field
5 Interview Report No. 08001589.)
- 6 • On August 30, 2008 at 4:30 p.m., SFPD officers observed 14 known DBG gang members
7 and associates together at a Kezar Pavilion youth football gang, including the following
8 Wallace "Gater" Pellette, Jason "Jumbo" Jones, Joseph "Stub/z" Smith, Deantray "Tray"
9 Reed, Kim "KI" Mitchell, Kevin "Duke" Mitchell, Aliton "Tiggz" Woodson, and an
10 Oakdale Mob gang member.
- 11 • On October 18, 2008, at 7:00 p.m., Wallace "Gater/Swally" Pellette was arrested for
12 possession of marijuana for sale. (Police Incident Report No. 081115557 and Field
13 Interview Report No. 08001386.) According to the report, Pellette was loitering at 1761
14 Sunnydale Avenue , in the Proposed Safety Zone, with known DBG members and
15 associates, including Alsedee "Jizz Mac" Green and Woodson. During a search incident
16 to Pellette's probation status, Pellette was found to be in possession of marijuana
17 packaged for sales. Pellette was convicted of marijuana possession.
- 18 • On November 26, 2008, at 3:40 p.m., Woodson was seen loitering at 60 Brookdale
19 Avenue, in the Proposed Safety Zone, with known DBG members and associates
20 including Raymond "Boo Gotti" Rodgers, Jason "Jumbo" Jones, Alsedee "Jizz Mac"
21 Green, Joseph "Stub/z" Smith. (Field Interview Report No. 08001667.)
- 22 • On January 5, 2009, at 2:30 p.m., SFPD officers were looking for known DBG gang
23 member/associate Jason "Jumbo" Jones, to question him regarding a December 31, 2008
24 shooting. (Police Incident Report No. 090015263.) According to the report, SFPD
25 officers observed Woodson with Jason "Jumbo" Jones, Joseph "Stub/z" Smith, Alsedee
26 "Jizz Mac" Green, and Stephen "Stevie Mac" Glass loitering in front of 1759 Sunnydale,
27 in the Proposed Safety Zone.

- On April 14, 2009, at 3:47 p.m., Woodson was seen loitering at 1514 Sunnydale Avenue, in the Proposed Safety Zone, with known DBG members and associates, including Alsedee "Jizz Mac" Green. (Field Interview Report No. 09000353.)
- On April 19, 2009, at 2:29 pm, members of DBG and TOWERSIDE congregated at Blythdale Avenue and Hahn Street, in the Proposed Safety Zone. Green, along with ten other DBG members and associates including Raymond "Boo Gotti" Rodgers and Woodson were present. Ten TOWERSIDE gang members and associates were present, including Vincent "VC" Floyd, Marcus "Young Monz" Gaines, Ceabe "CB" Justin, and Diondre "D-Nice" Young. Green asked SFPD officers if they would just let the two groups fight. Members from both groups taunted one another yelling, throwing hands in the air, and challenging and taunting one another.
